SAMBURU



Samburu and Meru are two captivating destinations in Kenya that offer unique wildlife experiences and a rich cultural heritage. Samburu, located in the northern part of the country, is known for its rugged landscapes and diverse wildlife. Visitors can embark on game drives and spot the "Samburu Special Five" - the Grevy's zebra, reticulated giraffe, Somali ostrich, Beisa oryx, and the gerenuk. The region is also home to the Samburu people, who have preserved their traditional way of life and offer visitors a glimpse into their rich culture. Meru, on the other hand, is a hidden gem with lush forests, rivers, and rolling hills. It is home to Meru National Park, which offers excellent opportunities for game viewing, including the chance to spot elephants, lions, leopards, and rhinos. The park is also famous for its beautiful landscapes, such as the stunning Elsa's Kopje, named after the lioness made famous by the book and movie "Born Free." Both Samburu and Meru provide a unique and off-the-beaten-path safari experience, allowing visitors to immerse themselves in the beauty of nature and the vibrant local cultures.

FAM TRIP ITINERARY

Day 1, Thursday, 16th November 2023

Welcome to MagicalKenya!

Upon arrival in Nairobi, you will be met and transferred to your respective hotels where you will spend the night.

Day 2, Friday, 17 November 2023

- After early morning breakfast, transfer to Wilson Airport for your flight transfer to Samburu. Upon arrival, arrival check into your lodge or camp and settle in.
- Briefing, camp/lodge inspection
- Lunch at the camp/lodge
- Afternoon embark on an exciting game drive in Samburu National Reserve, known for its unique wildlife and stunning landscapes. Keep an eye out for the "Samburu Special Five" - the Grevy's zebra, reticulated giraffe, Somali ostrich, Beisa oryx, and gerenuk. Enjoy the thrill of spotting elephants, lions, leopards, and other iconic African animals in their natural habitat.
- Return to your camp/lodge for dinner and overnight stay at the camp.

Day 3, Saturday, 18 November 2023

- After breakfast, start your day with an early morning game drive when wildlife is most active. Watch the sunrise and search for animals waking up. Keep an eye out for the "Samburu Special Five".
- Mid-morning: visit a local Samburu village to learn about their culture and traditions. This is an opportunity to interact with the Samburu people and gain insights into their way of life.
- Lunch: Return to your lodge or camp breakfast.
- Afternoon: Another game drive in Samburu National Reserve. Explore different areas of the reserve to maximize your wildlife viewing opportunities.
- Evening: Enjoy a sundowner and a dinner back at your lodge or camp.

Day 4, Sunday, 19th November 2023

- After breakfast, check out, bid farewell to Samburu, and fly back to Nairobi. Take in the aerial views of the landscapes you explored during your safari adventure.
- Upon arrival in Nairobi, pick up and transfer to the hotel for check-in
- Overnight at Nairobi hotel and ready for the Expo the following day
